

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE MORTON ARBORETUM

Tuesday, July 6, 2010

The Morton Arboretum is a 1700 acre glorious outdoor museum with magnificent trees, colorful gardens, a tallgrass prairie, a Children's Garden and maze, and other natural areas for you and your family to enjoy. Walking paths, roads, trails and even an open-air tram ride make most of the area accessible for exploration. There is a map/guide of the Arboretum in your goodie bag, so you can plan your visit.

The Rally Banquet will be held outdoors, under a tent, at the Arboretum (follow the signs from the Visitors Center). We encourage you to drive out to the Arboretum any time that day and enjoy the area prior to the banquet. The park closes at dusk, so if you want to explore it, you will have to do so before the banquet starts. The Visitors Center, Store, and Children's Garden all close at 6 pm. The Social Hour will start at 6 pm; a Buffet dinner will start at 7 pm.

Driving directions to the Arboretum, from Pheasant Run Resort are below. It is about 20 miles and will take approximately 30 minutes to drive there.

Left (west) out of Pheasant Run Resort, onto E. Main Street/North Ave.—go about 1 mi.

Left (south) on Kirk Road. You will stay on this road for approx. 7.5 miles

Left (east) on Butterfield Rd. (also known as Rte. 56) for approx. 11 miles

Right (south) on Park Blvd. for about one mile.

Morton Arboretum entrance will be in front of you, across highway 53. Enter under the metal archway. Drive up to the attendant in the "little houses" and tell them you are with the Porsche Club. You will not have to pay for parking, as it is included in the price of the Rally Banquet ticket. Park in the parking lot and walk up to the Visitors Center.
